2/3-2/5 AMERICAN RIVER CCC CABIN

We will be staying in a beautiful little cabin located in the heart of the central Cascades recreation area in Eastern Washington along the scenic Mather Memorial Parkway. The cabin was built as a guard station back in 1941 and served as a summer residence and work site for fire patrols and recreation management personnel in the early days. The building was built by the men of the 932nd Camp Naches Civilian Conservation Corps, actively staffed and used until the 70's after which it largely remained vacant. In 1999 the cabin was found eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places. Restoration of the cabin began in 2004, so currently it has electric heat and lights and a kitchen with stove and refrigerator! There is also a living room with hardwood floors and a wood stove room, and bedrooms in the second story. A rare opportunity to travel back in time to the 40's! The tour skiing and snowshoeing in the area effectively starts from our front door but the area gives us access to the Naches and the Tieton and the Bumping Lake valleys. The Naches River Valley was historically the primary access route to Puget Sound for the Yakima Indians of a hundred years ago. Today the route is plowed to the Morse Creek Valley east of Chinook, providing access to Morse and Bumping valleys. The Morse Creek Valley is a beautiful and gentle forested ravine in the southern segment of the Norse Peak Wilderness. The Bumping Lake area just south of Morse also offers beautiful and secluded cross-country skiing. The next drainage south of this is the Tieton River, this is a cross country skier only road past Clear Lake into the heart of the Goat Rocks wilderness. Provided: transit, lodging, meals at cabin.
