Club Nordic Ski Bus 2016

On Thursdays and weekends through the winter we go on bus trips to the Cascades for cross country skiing and snowshoe trips. We try to go to a new destination each trip and pick the spot based on what looks like the best possible weather and snow conditions. Over the past many years we have had some very memorable days coasting through pillows of powder along scenic ridge tops, and plunging into groves of old growth trees on a silent winter day with flakes drifting down all around. Our range is from Mt. Baker to Mt. Rainier and everywhere in between. Each bus series includes five (5) trips that run every other week through the season from January to early March. The Seattle Sunday bus starts on January 3 (1/3), Thursdays start 1/7, Saturdays on 1/9 and the Federal Way Sundays start 1/10. We leave town about 8am returning usually by about 5pm. We have pickups in Seattle, Bellevue, and Federal Way before the bus whisks us away to the fresh air and sparkling snow of the Cascade Range. Please come and join us for a winter of new adventures. 11/21 REDTOP MOUNTAIN DAY TRIP: Like all old fire lookout locations, the vistas from the top are 360 degrees and spectacular, with a ski up that is mostly on old logging roads. \$43

12/5 GARRISON SPRINGS: High in the eastern Cascades is this place apart from the world. There is a small network of trails through deep woods and overlooking a small valley. \$43

1/3, 1/31, 3/6 SNOWSHOE DAY TRIPS: A great opportunity to spend a day snowshoeing in the Cascades, each trip will be to a different destination. These are full day trips and offer the opportunity to make it to the top of a summit or just shuffle along the banks of a crystal clear river. \$43/trip

1/18-19 BAKER LAKE (M.L.KING TRIP): Baker Lake is easily accessible but situated so close to Mt. Baker and Shuksan that it has an alps like feel. Good views of these and other peaks are had from all the ridge tops here. \$120

2/29-3/2 WHITE PASS OVERNIGHT: White Pass is hard to get to but well worth the drive, with one of my favorite local nordic track systems, great lift skiing across the road and access to the Goat Rocks backcountry for some real off trail tour skiing. \$360

1/4-6 SUN MOUNTAIN SKI AND SNOWSHOE:

Right after the holidays this four star resort gets very quiet, (and less expensive). Fortunately for us the skiing is frequently some of the best of the year. In 2014 we had a foot of new on the ground and Christmas icicles on all the eaves. Cost \$386

1/11-15 GLACIER & WHITEFISH MT: Our train ride will take us the old world way to the foot of the continental divide and Glacier National Park. The lodging here is in a beautiful golf resort hotel with ski/snowshoe tracks right out front and the Rockies out the back door. Cost \$696

1/25-30 STEAMBOAT SPRINGS CO: has a long standing reputation as a world class ski town, but not many know that long before the resort was built the main form of winter transportation and indeed recreation here was Nordic skiing, during the harsh and snowy Rock Mountain winters. Cost \$954

2/1-3 PEMBERTON BC:Just north of Whistler is Pemberton where tour skiing is the rule and the cross country skiing is like it used to be, uncrowded, quiet, and serene. Some of the finest backcountry ski terrain in Southwestern BC lies east of town where Highway 99 climbs through the Cayoosh Range and runs past Duffey Lake. Cost \$338

2/13-15 PRESIDENTS' DAY WEEKEND: Silver Star and Sovereign Lakes have one of the most extensive nordic track systems in western Canada. The higher altitudes keep the snow dry and the trail side warming huts and ski village at the base add to the European charm. Cost \$382

2/16-27 JAPAN IN WINTER: The largest ice sculpture festivals, the most ski areas per capita, some of the most snowfall in the world and still few know how magical Japan is in the winter. We will be skiing and touring national parks, looking for the rare red crowned crane, viewing snow monkeys, and sleeping in traditional onsens with tatami mats. remember to leave your ski boots at the door! Cost \$2390-\$3580

3/7-14 ADIRONDACKS & LAKE PLACID The Adirondacks are a huge natural reserve of 6 million acres, 1/4 of the state. The park is a region of stunning natural beauty that includes remote and secluded retreats, wild lakes, and some of the most spectacular mountains in the eastern U.S. Cost \$1713
