

Saint Edward State Park: (14445 Juanita Dr NE, Kenmore) This park comprises over 3,000 feet of Lake Washington waterfront, and 316 acres of land; including the connected Big Finn Hill Park it is almost 500 acres total. This area was logged back in the 1800's and early 1900's before the developed core became a Catholic Seminary, and now the site of Bastyr University. Currently the park has many miles of trails for hikers, bikers and dog walkers. The upper trails off of Juanita Dr. are fairly flat the bluff trails down to the beach provide more elevation gain. The beach is usually the most crowded part of the park, but to beat the crowds explore Big Finn Hill (NE 138th & Juanita Dr NE) to the Southeast. The parks are currently open for day use (pets must be on leash). (Go Outside! 1 World Outing Club)
