Nordic Ski Bus 2020

On Thursdays and weekends through the winter we go on bus trips to the Cascades for cross country skiing and snowshoe trips. We try to go to a new destination each trip and pick the spot based on what looks like the best possible weather and snow conditions. Over the past many years we have had some very memorable days coasting through pillows of powder along scenic ridge tops, and plunging into groves of old growth trees on a silent winter day with flakes drifting down all around. Our range is from Mt. Baker to Mt. Rainier and everywhere in between. Each bus series includes five (5) trips that run every other week through the season from January to early March. The Saturday bus starts on 1/11 (January 11th), Federal Way Sundays start 1/12, Thursdays begin 1/9, and the Sunday bus starts 1/5. We leave town about 8am returning usually by about 5pm. We have pickups in Seattle, Bellevue, and Federal Way before the bus whisks us away to the fresh air and sparkling snow of the Cascade Range. Please come and join us for a winter of new adventures. Bus series cost is \$220 plus your annual membership in the club: \$20 for individuals or \$25 for families (5 Bus Trip Season \$240).

11/23 DIRTY FACE MOUNTAIN LOOP: Named after "Dirtyface" Barnard, and site of a historic fire lookout in the early 1900's, there are fabulous vistas and a possible loop ski/snowshoe. Cost \$48

12/1 GREEN MOUNTAIN & THREE FINGERS: This high ridge offers wonderful topography and views of many of the North Cascades' prettiest glaciated summits. Cost \$48

12/19 CUMBERLAND CREEK & IRON MT: Much like scenic Pilchuck Mt. this summit is perched on the western edge of the Cascade foothills with sweeping vistas of the Skagit River estuary. Cost \$48

1/5,2,2,3/8 SNOWSHOE DAY TRIPS: A great opportunity to spend a day snowshoeing in the Cascades, each full day trip will be to a different destination, and offer the opportunity to make it to the top of a summit or just shuffle along a crystal clear stream. \$48/trip

1/20-21 LEAVENWORTH TRIP: This is just a great place to visit during the winter when it looks all the more like a little Austrian village on the edge of the European Alps. Cost \$196

2/3-2/5 AMERICAN RIVER CCC CABIN: Travel back in time with us to stay in a 1970's Citizen Conservation Corps cabin in the heart of the American River canyon. Cost \$292

3/2-4 MOUNT CATHERINE HISTORIC SKI: This ski loop is as old as the sport of cross country skiing in our region, part tour ski, part groomed and all about a classical ski. Cost \$277

1/6-8 SUN MOUNTAIN SKI/SNOWSHOE: This is one of the nicest four star ski lodges sitting on a mountain top, at the core of the largest groomed Nordic ski trail network in the U.S.. Cost \$407

1/14-17 WINTER IN HOLDEN VILLAGE: It's hard to find a more off the grid low stress spot than Holden Village in the heart of the North Cascades National Park and accessible only by ferry. This has become a Mecca for backcountry skiers. Cost \$692

1/27-31 PARK CITY UTAH: The valley where most of the 2002 Olympics were staged primarily because of the high altitudes, the snow quality and the predominantly clear weather conditions. Cost \$1,509

2/14-17 PRESIDENT'S DAY IN KAMLOOPS BC: Always a popular weekend to get away, the Kamloops area is at the northern tip of the Coquihalla Hwy and at the heart of the Nordic skiing and snowshoeing in southern BC with access to the remarkable Larch Hills center; larger and more diverse than Silver Star and Sovereign Lakes combined. Cost \$387

2/24-29 SKI ASPEN ON A BUDGET: This world renowned elite beautiful alpine valley has the largest free cross country ski trail network in the country, and some of the nicest galleries, restaurants and craftsmanship you will find. Cost \$1,383

3/9-14 SILVERTON MOUNTAIN COLORADO: Imagine a high mountain basin that averages 400" of snow a season. There is only one ski lift, the trees and terrain were all left in their natural state; no groomers, no clearcuts, nearly unlimited advanced glades and chutes, and they limit ticket sales to less than 100 people a day. That's Silverton Mt.! Cost \$1,997

3/16-25 SWITZERLAND, EUROPE'S HIGHEST PEAKS: Our group will visit the renowned summits of the Swiss Alps: the Jungfrau, Eiger, the Matterhorn, Mt. Rose and more. We will ride the famous funicular mountain trains and tour the high plateaus. Cost \$2,749

4/4-4/10 PRINCE WILLIAM SOUND BY BOAT: This is some of the most remote skiing left anywhere in the world, and we will be touring the area by ship, landing each day for a new, possibly first ever ski route. Cost \$3,877
