2/14-17 PRESIDENT'S DAY IN KAMLOOPS BC

Given its proximity, its beautiful mountain valley setting and its multifaceted selection of Nordic skiing opportunities, it is surprising so few people know about this region of Canada. Kamloops was the chosen northern terminus for the huge \$848 million dollar Coquihalla Highway project over 4,081' high Coquihalla Pass. In this part of Canada we are between the coast range and the Rockies so the snow is plentiful but the weather is typically better than on the coast. Overlander Ski Club just 20 minutes out of town has 60km of groomed trails and is a local favorite. Kane Valley between Kamloops and the pass has 50km or trails and is known for some of the best snow and weather in the region and no crowds! There is of course Sun Peaks which has about 38km of trails at the base of the mountain and a single ride pass system for back country and telemark skiers to access the high country behind the alpine ski area. Then there is Larch Hills Nordic with 128km of trails with options for skiing through Old Growth, or wetland fens, spectacular vistas, or even an interpretive trail. This system is more massive and more diverse than Silver Star and Sovereign Lakes combined. The town itself is a neat destination for lovers of snow and snow sports. The ground is often white in the city itself, and there are many good restaurants for the gourmet or the gourmand in the group. They have a wild animal park, shops, galleries, and theaters and have gone through quite the transition since the Highway opened back in 1986. The highway that was so important to this area's development might never have been constructed if not for the Government fast tracking the project to open in time for Expo86.
