2/15-18 PRESIDENT'S DAY AT MT. SPOKANE:

The low snow year of 2015 brought this area to my attention. When all the other Coast Range ski areas were suffering from lack of snow and only able to operate a few weeks, the ski areas 49 Degrees North and Mt. Spokane were able to operate most of the season. It helped that they were in the high Selkirk Mountains of northeastern Washington, but this was a great feat nonetheless. The wildlife in this quiet corner of the state is remarkable. The caribou in the Selkirk Mountains of Washington and Idaho are the last remaining herd in the continental United States. With a little luck we may see some. Wildlife listings make the Colville National Forest sound like Alaska: caribou, moose, wolf, lemming, grizzly bear. The northeastern corner of the Colville National Forest seems, in some ways, like a little piece of the arctic. The big attraction in this area is 49 Deg. North, Coeur d'Alene, and the Mt.Spokane trails which have been continually upgraded and now boast almost 60 km. of groomed trails. There are also a series of snow park areas in town and in the Colville National Forest just north of town. They have been working since the early 1970s, in conjunction with Washington State Parks, to build and expand this trail system for mountain biking and cross country skiing. There are several snow park areas in these forests and a dedicated touring center with on trail warming huts. Last year we skied the Sherman Pass area and had some amazing cold smoke powder all to ourselves.
