More than 100 fire lookouts still stand across Washington, and only 30 are still actively used for fire-fighting. Many are lovingly tended by volunteers and are still open to the public, while others have fallen into disuse. The nice thing about fire lookouts is that almost all of them have an incredible 360 degree view, ten times better than the one your friend has from that expensive view house on the lake.

Redtop is accessible by an easy hiking trail in summer and in summer or winter the lookout has a stunning setting. During the winter this lookout is accessible by logging road except for the last mile out the ridge. The road connects from Blewett Pass all the way over to 29 Pines and the Teanaway Road that we Nordic ski most winters with the day trip buses. The ski up from these lower altitudes is just too far to go in mid winter, thirteen miles from the West

(Teanaway), and over seven from the Iron Creek side. This early in the season the hope is that we will be able to drive part of the way up before we hit snow and then ski the rest of the distance from there.
