### 8/10 EAST BANK ROSS LAKE TRAIL

North Cascades National Park has perhaps the youngest and most jagged set of uplifted mountains in the lower 48 with some of the most remote valleys and summits. Though with all this sequestered beauty it is probably the least visited of our local National Parks with only 30,000 hikers, skiers, and campers last year. So this will be the other end of the spectrum from the Blue Ridge Parkway we visited last year with its almost 15 million visitors annually. The North Cascades just celebrated its 50th anniversary last year (2018) so we definitely need to take a trip to this beautiful corner of our state this summer. We had a rare chance to tour ski into this area last winter and saw a bobcat on our drive, and lots of other wildlife and awe inspiring mountains and glaciers on the trip. There was a beautiful article in the April 28th Pacific Magazine about Scott Kranz's celebration of the anniversary event by climbing 50 of the Parks highest summits. We will not be rock climbing of course but will be hiking the East Bank trail along the east side of Ross Lake (reservoir). This should offer wonderful vistas of many of Scott's summits and many others. This trail takes us into the heart of the Park. This is a long drive and we want to have enough time in the woods so we will be leaving the park and ride early, 7am. Be sure to bring your cameras! Provided: transit, maps. Date 8/10 Cost \$47
