3/16-25 EUROPE'S HIGHEST PEAKS TOUR OF SWITZERLAND

Come and visit the motherland of mountains and snow. Switzerland Austria has always been the high range of the European continent, where steep mountains meet blue sky, deep valleys and shining peaks reign. The country has been a safe haven for its culture and a barrier from invading armies for centuries. The country became the symbol of neutrality and has been preserved through the ages with no armed conflicts on its soil. The mountains were so imposing and impenetrable that the country itself is divided into four separate regions by language. The west next to France speaks French, the south speaks Italian, and the north German. We will be visiting some of the highest and most remarkable mountains and towns in all of Europe. Our flight will whisk us off to Zurich where we will board the train to Interlaken for a few days of tour skiing. I have visited this valley during the summer and it is remarkable, very reminiscent of the opening scenes in The Sound of Music. We will have the opportunity on this trip to visit most if not all of the most famous European summits. The Jungfrau at 13,642' is accessible by train out of Interlaken. The remarkable glaciated barrier wall of the Eiger should be visible from the observation point on the Jungfrau. Then perhaps the most famous peak in all of Europe, the Matterhorn, can be seen from our midway point at Zermatt before we board the famous Glacier Express train for a day of travel across the mountainous southern border of the country. to St. Moritz and and up to Lucerne. All itineraries to Switzerland have to include a stay in this quintessential Swiss town. Walk the old castle/defense wall, walk through the shops in old town, take a boat trip to one of the villages on the immense Lake Vierwaldstattersee, or go for a hike in the park behind town.
