9/14 TOLMIE PEAK FIRE LOOKOUT

Perhaps the best view in the state of the iconic Mt. Rainier from the northwest side is from Tolmie Lookout, or perhaps across Eunice Lake toward the peak on a sunny still day, with Eunice acting as a reflecting pond. This is the perspective we all share from Seattle on a clear day, but once you have seen the mountain from this close the Seattle perspective will never be the same. This is a fairly easy eight mile hike with only about 1,000' gain to the 6,000' summit. There are few places in the state where you can get such a view as this with less work against gravity to get to those kind of altitudes. The WTA calls this area "Tolmie Peak and Eunice Lake ... picturesque in the extreme". The trail is relatively gentle up to Ipsut Pass and only there starts to gain altitude rapidly for the last mile or so. The wild flowers will have done for the season here at this time of year but often there are highland huckleberries (mountain blueberries) fruiting. Please remember to bring your national park pass for the entrance gate. Provided: transit, maps. Date 9/14 Cost \$47
