

3/20-22 YAKIMA/TIETON SKI WEEKEND

Many years ago the state highway department used to keep Cayuse Pass open during the winter; however they were never able to maintain Chinook Pass as it gets too much snow to keep it plowed. We have skied this area in the spring when they are struggling to open it, frequently plowing through drifts of 30 feet or more of snow. Because of the inaccessibility, skiing the east approach to this pass has always been difficult. This trip is set up to give us access to the great skiing opportunities in this area. Our group will travel over Snoqualmie Pass to accommodations in Yakima, which gives us convenient access to the Naches and the Tieton and the Bumping Lake valleys. The Naches River Valley was historically the primary access route to Puget Sound for the Yakima Indians of a hundred years ago. Today the route is plowed to the Morse Creek Valley east of Chinook, providing access to Morse and Bumping Valley. The Morse Creek Valley is a beautiful and gentle forested ravine in the southern segment of the Norse Peak

Wilderness. The Bumping Lake area just south of Morse also offers beautiful and secluded crosscountry skiing. The next drainage South of this is the Tieton River, this is a cross country skier only road past Clear Lake into the heart of the Goat Rocks Wilderness. Provided: transit, lodging, maps.
